

Applied Music Major Requirements

Guitar, Orchestral Instruments, Organ, Piano, and Strings (117-120 credits): Music core (36 credits) plus 9-15 credits of division-approved upper-level MUSIC or MUHST electives; 36 credits of MUSAP applied instruction; 1-18 credits of electives; 1-2 credits of recitals; and 10-12 credits of MUSEN ensembles. See the music undergraduate adviser for additional specific requirements in each area.

Voice (119-121 credits): Music core (36 credits) plus 12 credits of division-approved upper-level MUSIC or MUHST electives which may include up to 3 credits of MUHST at the 300 level, MUSIC 307, MUSIC 308, MUSIC 309, MUSIC 326, MUSIC 327, MUSIC 328, MUSIC 434, MUSIC 460, MUSIC 461, MUSIC 462, MUSIC 379, MUSIC 479; 36 credits of MUSAP applied instruction; and 10-12 credits of MUSEN ensembles, and 3 credits of music electives. The voice major also requires proficiency through the third quarter college level in two languages from French, German, and Italian.

Composition (114-120 credits): Music core (36 credits) plus MUSIC 216, MUSIC 217, and MUSIC 218 (6); PHYS 207 (3); 18 credits of division-approved upper-level MUSIC or MUHST electives; MUSIC 380, MUSIC 381, MUSIC 382, MUSIC 400, MUSIC 401, MUSIC 490, MUSIC 471 or MUSIC 472; 18 credits of private instruction in composition, MUSIC 391-MUSIC 491; two years of MUSAP private applied-music instruction (12-18); 6 credits of MUSEN ensembles; and one 400-level course in ethnomusicology.

Jazz Studies (112-116 credits): Music core (36 credits) plus 9 credits of division-approved upper-level MUSIC or MUHST electives (see adviser for approved list); MUSIC 331 or MUSIC 319, MUSIC 425, MUSIC 336, MUSIC 436, MUSIC 467, MUSIC 468, MUSIC 469, MUSIC 379, MUSIC 479; 6 credits of MUSIC 464; 10-12 credits of approved MUSIC electives; 30 credits of MUSAP private applied-music instruction; 12 credits of MUSEN ensembles.

A minimum of 180 credits, of which 90 must be taken in departments other than the School of Music. Piano proficiency at MUSAP 135 level. All College of Arts and Sciences graduation requirements must be met. Cumulative GPA of 2.50 for all music courses and a minimum grade of 2.0 for each music course.

Major Requirements

Music Theory-History Option Track (63 credits): Music core, plus 6 credits of 300-level MUHST electives, 6 credits of 400-level MUSIC or MUHST electives, 10 credits of MUSAP vocal or instrumental private applied instruction, 5 credits of MUSEN (ensembles).

Woeal or Instrumental Option <u>Track</u> (69 credits): Music core, plus 6 credits of approved upper-level MUSIC or MUHST electives which may include up to 3 credits of MUHST at the 300 level, 18 credits of MUSAP vocal or instrumental private applied instruction, and 9 credits in ensembles.

Vocal Track (75 credits): Music core, plus 6 credits of approved upper-level MUSIC or MUHST electives which may include up to 3 credits of MUHST at the 300-level, 18 credits of MUSAP vocal private applied instruction, MUSIC 307, MUSIC 308, MUSIC 309, and 9 credits in ensembles. The vocal track also requires proficiency through the third quarter college level in two languages from French, German, and Italian.
