In the past, string performance majors in the BA/BM and BM degree programs were required to take Music 326, 327, 328 (2,2,2) for a total of 6 "repertoire" credits.

In place of this generic sequence, the String Division proposes that string performance majors be required to take a new, more specific course: Music 429, String Orchestral Repertoire (2)

The justification for this new course is that this class, for string performance majors, should be an orchestral repertoire class which would be used for providing necessary training in orchestral repertoire excerpts. We want to offer the course ... We feel that the training and study of orchestral excerpts our students will receive will prepare them for the possibility of:

- a) Winning an audition for a job in a professional paid orchestra.
b) Mastering the repertoire they will need in an orchestral career.

It should be noted that entirely new repertoire will be studied each quarter and repertoire studied each quarter will not be repeated for at least 5 years. Students will take the course a minimum of 3 times for a total of 6 credits.
