The changes are being made to update the General Catalog to reflect the correct courses and credits for the major requirements. There were two courses missing (CM 311 and CM 422) from the list of Foundation courses, and one course was moved from an elective to a required course (BCMU 301). Additionally, the credits for the Capstone Experience (CM 431) were increased from 4 to 5 credits.
