The department MHE Minor Committee reviewed the minor requirements to make sure we are current with student needs. We have made changes to the core course selection and updated the electives by adding some new relevant course offerings and removing courses that are no longer being offered:

- Add MHE 481 as a core course selection.
- Remove ANTH 322/RELIG 320; professor is retired and it is unknown when the course will be offered again.
- Remove ENG 364; professor has left and it is unknown when the course will be offered again.
- Remove HIST 290 and 490: special topics not necessarily offered regularly.

Minor Requirements: 25 credits of medical history and ethics and related courses (15 of which must be MHE), including the following courses in core competencies: MHE 401 or MHE 417 and one of the following MHE 411, MHE 474, PHIL 240, or PHIL 242. Choose additional elective credits to total 25 core plus elective credits from any of the courses listed above which were not used to fulfill core competencies or from MHE 402/PHIL 342, 404/PHIL 344, MHE 413, MHE 422, MHE 424, MHE 440/PHIL 459, MHE 481, MHE 483, MHE 485, MHE 497, MHE 498, MHE 499, ANTH-322/RELIG-320, ANTH 375, ANTH/HSERV 475, ANTH 476, 477, ENGL-364, GEOG 280, HIST-314, HIST-312, PHIL 102, PHIL 160, PHIL 345, PHIL 410, and PHIL 440. Minimum grade of 2.0 required in each course presented for the minor.

Additional credits selected from the following electives to total 25 credits; 15 credits must be MHE courses: MHE 401*, MHE 402 / PHIL 412, MHE 404 / PHIL 413, MHE 411*, MHE 417*, MHE 440 / PHIL 459, MHE 474* / PHIL 411*, MHE 481*, MHE 483, MHE 485, MHE 497, MHE 498, MHE 499; ANTH 305, ANTH 308, ANTH 375, ANTH 474, ANTH 475 / HSERV 475, ANTH 476, ANTH 477; CHID 332, CHID 433; GEOG 280, GEOG 380, GEOG 480; HIST 311, HIST 312; HSTAA 316; NURS 200, NURS 410; PHIL 102, PHIL 160, PHIL 240*, PHIL 242*, PHIL 345, PHIL 360, PHIL 409, PHIL 410, PHIL 415, PHIL 440, PHIL 460, PHIL 481, PHIL 482;

Total of 25 credits includes core courses. Any of the courses listed above in 1) and 2) may be used as electives if they are not counted toward the core requirements. *Signifies a core course. If an MHE course is cross-listed with another department's course, MHE credits toward the required 15 credits will be accepted.
