Currently incoming freshmen or transfer students can mark Physics as their intended major prior to enrollment. Due to the wording of Physics' current admissions requirement, once a student becomes matriculated they are automatically declared without visiting the department and signing the necessary paperwork to confirm that Physics is their intended major. By requiring students to visit the office we are able to better ensure that Physics makes a good fit for their interests and initial contact with the student has been made.
