Based on the recommendation of its Subcommittee on Admissions and Programs, the Faculty Council on Academic Standards has recommended approval of the revised requirements for (1) the Bachelor of Arts degree in Slavic Languages and Literature for both the options in Russian Language, Literature, and Culture and East European Languages, Literature, and Culture, and (2) the minors in Russian Language, Russian and Slavic Literatures, and Slavic Languages. A copy of the change is attached.

I am writing to inform you that the Department of Slavic Languages and Literatures is authorized to specify these requirements beginning autumn quarter 2007.



The East European option must be completed with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 in all BCS, BULGR, CZECH, HSTEU, POLSH, SISJE, SISRE and SLAV courses completed (UW and transfer), with a minimum grade of 2.0 in each course presented for the major. Transfer students are required to complete at least 15 graded credits in Slavic department courses at the UW.
