The Technical Japanese Program is undergoing a curriculum reform aimed at more efficient use of its teaching resources and more effective instruction while meeting new student needs. This reform involves the integration of TC461, 462, 463 (Technical Japanese 1, 2, 3) and TC471, 472, 473 (Oral Communication in Japanese in Technical and Business Settings 1, 2, 3) into a *new* course sequence: TC461, 462, 463 (Japanese for Technical and Business Professions 1, 2, 3), which will replace the current TC461, 462, 463 and TC471, 472, 473. (Because TJP's 500-level courses are TC561, 562, 563, we prefer to use TC461, 462, 463 for the new courses.) The integration gives the instructor more flexibility in designing syllabuses and course activities, and allows him to achieve the same instructional goals with fewer contact hours by eliminating duplication in the current TC46x and TC 47x. Given the changes above, the required credits need to be changed. The proposed the changes are as follows:

<u>Current</u>: Minimum of 27 credits to include TC461 (3), TC462 (3), TC463 (3), TC471 (3), TC472 (3), and TC473 (3), plus 9 credits from the approved list of elective courses.

New: Minimum of 25 credits to include TC461 (5), TC462 (5), TC463 (5), plus 10 credits from the approved list of elective courses.
