EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

Math 310 is a sophomore-level course, and a gateway course for math majors. It is not an appropriate course to count for credit toward the math minor. In a separate course change application, we have proposed re-numbering 310 as 300. Then our proposed program change is simply that only courses numbered 301 and above may be counted for credit toward the math minor.

We would also like to propose that our current statement regarding the residency requirement for the minor become part of our curriculum so that we can enforce a residency requirement for our minor.
