Although we required the theory (Micro 301) and highly recommended the laboratory (Micro 302), students at UW were not always able to get a lab spot in Micro 302. Transfer students take this course as a combined course, theory and lab included. The State of Board of Nursing is now requiring that all nursing schools require theory and laboratory and we must require it starting immediately.
