EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

The Provost along with SOM Dean approved a name change for the Department of Medical History and Ethics effective 11/1/2008 to Bioethics and Humanities. The scope of teaching, research and service in the department has evolved considerably as a result of both new faculty and increasing demands for bioethics expertise within the School of Medicine and throughout the university. The name Bioethics and Humanities reflects the mission and scope of the department. In addition the name was selected to better represent the content of our curriculum. The department will admit its first cohort for a new Masters of Arts in Bioethics in Fall 2009. The undergraduate minor will be renamed to a Minor in Bioethics and Humanities to better reflect the academic goal of the program and its curriculum. We therefore request that the department's course prefix be changed to reflect the new expertise and focus of the department, curriculum and minor to "B H".
