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EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE For new program, please include any relevant supporting documentation such as student learning outcomes, projected enrollments, letters of support and departmental handouts. The proposed change would: (1) open the minor to newer 100-level courses that did not exist when the minor when first developed, such as SIS/NEAR E 150 (Israel: Dynamic Society & Global Flashpoint), GEOG/SIS 111 (Global Youth), and the recently-proposed SIS 101 (Issues in International Studies); (2) balance the new inclusion of 100-level courses with a somewhat more stringent requirement for at least 10 rather than 5 upper-division credits in the minor; (3) eliminate the recommendation that students in the minor take SIS 401. This course routinely fills with majors, cannot be enlarged with current TA constraints, and the recommendation produces aggravation for students and advisers alike.
