- 5 credits in any L ARCH courses (including all L ARCH summer offerings and up to 6 credits of L ARCH foreign study courses) or ESRM (210, 311, 331, 362, 402, 411, 451, 462, 463, 464, 471, 472, 473, 477, 478, 480, 481)
- 5 credits of courses with the prefix ARCH, CM, or URBDP
- A 2.0 minimum grade is required in all courses counted toward the minor.
