Due to enrollment pressure on our 300-level courses, it is often difficult for students to complete the current minor requirements in a timely manner. Requiring the same number of courses as heretofore, but reducing the number of required credits from 31 to 27 and allowing students to take ANY four 300-level elective Spanish courses should help to facilitate completion of the minor.
