*Minor Requirements:* Seven courses (minimum 31 credits) above the SPAN 203 level to include the following:

- 1. SPAN 301, SPAN 302, SPAN 303 (or SPAN 314, SPAN 315, SPAN 316; or SPAN 310; or SPAN 330).
- 2. Two of the following three core courses: SPAN 321, SPAN 322, SPAN 323.
- 3. Two 300-level electives. (400-level courses may be substituted for one or both electives.)
- 4. Only one course whose instructional materials are primarily in English may apply to the minor. SPAN 327 may not apply to the minor and is not open to heritage/native speakers.

Minor Requirements (minimum <u>27</u> credits) above the SPAN 203 level to include the following:

- 1. One of the following sequences: SPAN 301, SPAN 302, and either SPAN 303 or SPAN 330; SPAN 314, SPAN 315, and either SPAN 316 or SPAN 330; SPAN 310 and either SPAN 303, SPAN 316, or SPAN 330.
- 2. Four 300 or 400 level electives.
- Only one course whose instructional materials are primarily in English may apply to the minor. SPAN 327 may not apply to the minor and is not open to heritage/native speakers.
