EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE For new program, please include any relevant supporting documentation such as student learning outcomes, projected enrollments, letters of support and departmental handouts. (Use additional pages if necessary). <p>The Medical Anthropology and Global Health (MAGH) option within the major in Anthropology has been very successful and has generated great student demand. The requirement for one introductory level course is well justified, but has also created something of a bottleneck in terms of student enrollment pressures. In response, a new introductory course has been developed and will be offered for the first time in Spring 2012; the new course, ANTH 274 "Labor, Identity and Knowledge in Health Care," has been reviewed and approved at the Department level and is currently under review by the College of Arts & Sciences curriculum committee. This class introduces students to basic questions, concepts, and methods in medical anthropology through a focus specifically on the work of health care providers, a valuable additional option for our students, many of whom hope in the future to work in a health-related field. We are propose a change to the requirements for the MAGH option, to allow this new class to count as satisfying the requirement for an introductory-level medical anthropology class.</p>
