EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

<p>We would like to add Dance 242 (Music for Dance) to the list of electives for the Dance Studies major. The relation of music to dance, specifically, a basic understanding of music theory and rhythmic analysis has important applications to students interested in dance analysis, dance history and criticism, and dance ethnography. Dance 242 also provides a solid foundation and analytic tools for examining the relationship of music to dance in non-western societies, the content of Dance 250--gateway into the Dance Studies major.</p> <p>We also seek permission to add Dance 344 and Dance 345 to the list of electives for the Dance Studies major. Students pursuing Dance Studies must complete either Dance 344 or Dance 345 as a core course. These courses are offered alternate years. We would like students with a particular interest in dance history to have the option of taking a second dance history course as an elective.</p> <p>In addition we would like to add Dance 499 (Dance Independent Study) as a possible elective. We are seeing a wide variety of students interested in the Dance Studies Major and some of their interests and course work do not fit easily into our standard curriculum. Dance 499 provides an opportunity for faculty to work one-on-one with students on special projects related to their course of study.</p>
