
Dear Bob:

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**EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE**

This change amends the Russian Literature/Slavic Literature minor requirements to reflect the deletion of two courses no longer offered by the Slavic Department (RUSS 321 & RUSS 461). It also amends the minor to allow several new courses to count as electives (RUSS 110, RUSS 120, RUSS 210, RUSS 221, RUSS 223, RUSS 240, RUSS 424, SLAV 320, and SLAV 323). Only 5.0 credits at the 100-level (RUSS 110 or RUSS 120) are allowed to apply to the minor to encourage students to meet their requirements with more focused courses at the 200-level and above. Because RUSS 321 has been omitted as a specific requirement, the catalog language has been altered to reflect that students must choose 15 credits of elective courses, rather than 10.
