The faculty voted to change the UW Tacoma Criminal Justice residency requirement to 45cr out of the 65cr required for the major. The faculty voted for at least 45cr Criminal Justice courses (core or approved electives) be completed at UW Tacoma. In all cases a program petition for a course substitution will be submitted for review and approval. Students who have a 100-200 level transfer course that is considered similar in content to a 300-400 level course within the major will not repeat content, however they will be required to select a 300-400 level course from the Criminal Justice major approved elective list.
