3. Upper Admission. Requires 59 credits of coursework with at least a 2.50 GPA: MATH 124, MATH 125, and MATH 126; CHEM 142, CHEM 152, CHEM 162 (or CHEM 144, CHEM 154, and CHEM 164); CHEM 223 or CHEM 237; PHYS 121, PHYS 122; BIOL 180, BIOL 200; AMATH 301; and 5 credits of English composition. Any of BIOL 180, PHYS 122, and AMATH 301 may be in progress at time of application. A 2.50 GPA guarantees consideration but not admission. Application deadlines are February 1 for spring quarter and July 1 for autumn quarter. Consult the department's website or adviser for more details.
