EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

The proposed change removes IS 310 from the IS Option requirement and includes IS 451 as a new requirement. Over time, the student population for the IS Option has changed, as students already come with basic understanding of spreadsheets and presentation software, which are some of the topics covered in IS 310. Furthermore, IS 310 has a significant overlap with two other courses: IS 320 and IS 445. In short, a current student in the IS Option does not get much value out of IS 310.

On the other hand, IS 451, a new course dealing with data mining and business analytics covers a topic that has emerged as an important one for both IS and business professionals. It is necessary for the IS Option graduates to have this background for them to be competitive in the current labor market. IS 451 will, therefore, add a lot of value for the current students in the IS Option.
