EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

Proposed Change to the Creative Studies Option Requirement: Add 3 additional credits of Dance Composition to the core requirements. After completion of Composition I, students may opt to enroll in Composition II or Composition III to complete this new requirement.

Rationale:

The Creative Studies curriculum offers an in-depth study of dance as an art form and cultural practice, resulting in a rigorous balance between creative work and academic study. Students interested in dance performance, choreography, pedagogy, dance production, and other dance related fields are well served by the balance of academic and creative/studio-based courses. At present Composition I is the only choreography course required for the Creative Studies option; Composition II and Composition III are offered as electives. In addition, the full composition series (Comp I plus 6 credits in Comp II and/or Comp III, both of which may be repeated) is required for those majors interested in choreographing for the Dance Majors Concert. In our most recent assessment of the Creative Studies option curriculum, faculty discussed the need for an additional composition course. Composition I offers an introduction to improvisation and basic compositional tools for the development and manipulation of choreographic material. An additional quarter of composition is needed so that students can gain a greater command of compositional tools, and develop them further.
