With the increase in lower division credits due to the expansion to a 4-year university, the previous 65-credit requirement prevented students from taking advantage of some of our 100- and 200-level courses. 2. Faculty voted unanimously to reduce the current 45-credit requirement in "Areas of Knowledge" to conform to the minimum University requirement of 40. A total of 40 credits should be required in A of K, with a minimum of 10 credits in each of the three sub areas: VLPA, I & S, NW, OTHER DEPARTMENTS AFFECTED List all departments/units/ or co-accredited programs affected by your new program or changes to your existing program and acquire the signature of the chair/director of each department/unit listed.
