EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

The Archaeological Sciences Option has now been available to students for one year. The archaeology faculty have reviewed the program and found that the small number of 'core' courses makes it difficult for students to fulfill the obligations of the Option in a reasonable time. To remedy this problem they have decided to move some courses from the 'supplementary' list to the 'core' list. Also, since the Option was established, one 'core' six credit course has been split into two three credit courses (ARCHY 482 into ARCHY 482 and 486) so the archaeology faculty want to add ARCHY 486 to the 'core' list. We would also like to add ARCHY 372, ARCHY 373, ARCHY 467, ARCHY 561 and BIO A 487 to the core list
