EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

In spring quarter 2013, Jackson School courses in comparative religion and Jewish studies were removed from the JSIS and JSIS B curriculum headings and consolidated in the JSIS C heading. This modification means that the wording of Requirement #3 of the minor in International Studies must be revised to retain the intent of the original requirement. (The few courses originally in the JSIS C curriculum were not appropriate for the minor; as a result of the religion/Jewish studies consolidation, many of them are.)
