EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE					
For new program, please include any relevant supporting documentation such as student learning outcomes, projected enrollments,					
letters of support and departmental handouts. (<i>Use additional pages if necessary</i>). We propose a temporary suspension of admission to the Social Sciences BA in the Evening Degree program, through the end of Spring 2015, for several reasons:					
 Evening Degree enrollments have fallen dramatically. We are launching a new degree in the Integrated Social Sciences, with an access mission that parallels that of the Evening Degree program. We consider that these two degree programs have significant redundancy in goals, and it will be challenging to staff both. The Evening Degree Social Sciences degree is no longer considered sufficiently rigorous. Even without the creation of the ISS degree, which reflects what social science faculty consider to be an high quality social sciences degree, we would need a significant revision of this program. 					
If approved, we will admit an Autumn 2014 cohort, but not admit students in Winter 2015 or Spring 2015.					
We will of course ensure that all currently admitted students will have the opportunity to complete the program, but we cannot in good faith admit new students knowing the future of the program is unclear. By the end of Spring 2015, we will have made a decision about the long-term future of the program, and initiated the appropriate process.
