EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE For new program, please include any relevant supporting documentation such as student learning outcomes, projected enrollments, letters of support and departmental handouts. (Use additional pages if necessary). Assessment of this new program has been on-going. The Healthcare Leadership curriculum committee approved changes to add content to the core class, THLEAD 350, incorporating the content of THLEAD 450. In addition, it was decided to move the diversity content and requirement from THLEAD 407 to THLTH 310, so THLEAD 407 is no longer a required course. The need to add Healthcare Informatics to the curriculum led to the addition of THLEAD 405 & 406. THLEAD 406 will replace the TINST 311 requirement. To keep graduation requirements at the same number of credits, total elective credits have been reduced to 32 from 45. All 32 elective credits will now be general electives with 10 of those credits required at the upper division level.
