EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

UWT students are both members of their local communities and global citizens, exposed to a variety of world views and cultures. To become respectful and informed global citizens, it is vital to have an understanding of diverse religious beliefs and practices and how they interact with larger political and social systems. In terms of the UWT campus, course offerings in this minor will help to promote programmatic emphasis on interdisciplinarity, sustainability, and cross-cultural understanding. The proposed minor responds to student demand and utilizes the expertise of existing faculty. It will formalize existing offerings in the PPE program and more broadly in IAS without requiring additional resources, whilst at the same time leaving scope for future expansion.

Students must complete 25 Credit hours, with 10 required and 15 optional credits of which at least 10 should be upper-division.
