(See Addendum for DARS change).  **TEST 495*  Note that TESC 464 is the last course in the series for the Restoration Certificate and T GIS 415 is the last course in the series for the GIS Certificate. So the DARS requirement is the completion of these courses, but the language in the catalog refers to the certificate, which would be more familiar to a student.
