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EXPLANATION OF AND RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE

The Department of Global Health is proposing the following revisions to the Global Health Minor "Required Courses" requirements:

1. G H 210 (5 cr) – Convert this course to 3 credits so that it is consistent with the credit load for the other 'human biology' course option (G H 410, 3 cr) that forms part of the minor core.
2. G H 415 – Remove this course as an alternative to G H 101. This course is no longer being offered consistently.

These changes will result in the credit requirements for the *Required Courses* being set at 8 credits total, instead of 7-10 credits as it is currently.

Hi Jennifer,

I don't think this change will impact access to the minor for a couple reasons...

- As of AY 2014-15, the SPH major is no longer including 101 as a required course, though it is one of a handful of prerequisite course options
- Max enrollment in this course was 40 when it was offered, so these numbers will be easily absorbed in the winter course
- As of this fall, we have begun offering a DL version of the course, and plan to offer it both A 2014, and Spring 2015. I expect this to continue (eg, 2 DL offerings per year)
